Healthy Reward points **do not** carry over into the next term's prize period. All student's points scores start from zero at the start of a term's prize period.

DID YOU KNOW...?

Lots of promotions and offers will take place in the dining area e.g. **Healthy Rewards** which gives a points score for every item you purchase.

The healthier the item the more points you receive. Each term **£50** shopping vouchers are awarded to the 5 students with the most Healthy Rewards points.

We'll be using a variety of ways to make sure you keep getting the message about what's on offer within the dining areas.

There will be new digital information screens, & keep an eye on the school website. That way, you'll always know what's going down.

At each of the food service points you can pay for items individually, or you can take advantage of the great value meal deals.

The current standard price for these meal packages is **£2.30**, and for this you will typically get a main course item with sides and a dessert.

We hope you agree that for a nutritious & tasty 2 course meal this is great value.



HOW TO PAY

At Hanson School all payments for food or drink are made via our online payment system, which is called ParentPay.

Parents who don't have a credit/debit card can also use ParentPay; please request a PayPoint card (by calling 01274 776200) which you can top up at shops & petrol stations.

For students entitled to free school meals, you will have a daily allowance of £2.30 which is credited to your account automatically each day. You can also top up your account with additional money via ParentPay or PayPoint if you wish.
